Fruit Loop Rainbow



What you'll need:

- Paper
- Scissors
- Paint / markers or crayons
- Fruit loops
- Glue

Easy Steps:

- make a rainbow template for your child
- have you child sort fruit loops in different colours
- glue the fruit loops onto the template matching the colour

Tip:

This is a great activity for reviewing colours, sequencing and building some early math skills.
